What are the Youth Tour Scholarships?

The \$2,500 Gwyn B. Price Scholarship (established in 1981) and the \$2,000 Katie Bunch Memorial Scholarship (established in 1989) are awarded annually to participants of the previous year's youth tour.

What are the objectives of the Scholarships?

To aid a young person who has limited financial resources and has exhibited outstanding scholastic and leadership abilities in his/her quest for a college education. The North Carolina Association of Electric Cooperatives Volunteers' Committee established the program because of their desire to contribute to the development of future leaders who otherwise might not have the opportunity to continue their education.

Who is eligible to apply?

All current-year youth tourists who are rising seniors are eligible to apply for the scholarships.

When is the competition held?

Applications for the scholarships are made available to all eligible youth tourists in December. Deadline for applications is January 31, and the decision is made by a scholarship committee in February. The winner receives the scholarship during a special ceremony at NCEMC/NCAEC/TEMA Annual Meeting.

What are the criteria for selection?

Need	35%
Scholastic achievement	35%
Extracurricular activities (<i>school and community</i>)	30%

In addition, the winner must be accepted by an accredited four-year college or university.

How will the scholarship money be paid?

Directly to the college or university according to the institution's payment policy after NCAEC receives a letter from the college/university confirming student enrollment. Should a recipient withdraw from college, reimbursement of unused monies shall be made to NCAEC.

Are there any conditions to the scholarship?

In the event a recipient receives financial assistance from other sources which constitute a full scholarship, he/she shall notify NCAEC and relinquish rights to the Gwyn B. Price Scholarship or the Katie Bunch Memorial Scholarship. The monies shall then be awarded to the runner-up, provided that person meets all requirements.
